# Opening times

- The gates will open at 8:30am
- Doors open at 8:40am. Pupils may enter the class for 'morning tasks'
- Register is taken at 8:50am.
- Doors and gates locked at 9am.
- Entry after this time is marked as late.



# What can I do as a parent to help my child be ready for "big school" ?

- Toilet trained

- Be able to dress themselves



- Put their own shoes on correctly.(Velcro is their friend!)

- Put on their own coat (try before you buy)



- Be able to open their lunch box (try before you buy)
- Recognise their name or a symbol in the clothes and equipment so they can identify it.  
All sweatshirts look the same!
- **Name Label on ALL CLOTHING** that they are likely to take off eg Coat, uniform, PE Kit.  
This is important as all items of uniform are the same. If it's named we can return it to the right child.





# Important that we know...



Sometimes it's the little things that effect their day. If we know what may have triggered things then we can react accordingly.

- Has the goldfish died this morning? this is a big thing to a 4 year old !
- Is mum away overnight? Has Nana gone on holiday? - this is a change in their routine.
- Is their big brother off ill? - they want to stay off too!
- Confidential information - home life, medical, other things that can affect them indirectly or directly.

# General Information



- Infant children are entitled to a FREE healthy snack in the morning and a FREE school lunch. More details to follow.
- If our child brings a packed lunch it should be clearly labelled with a name on the box and bottle (Please note it is kept in the classroom-not a fridge!)
- PE bags sent in at the beginning of half term - Stay in school until half term when they are then sent home for a wash.
- Book bags brought in daily.  
NOTE your child will be provided with a book bag.

# Uniform

*A range of uniform may be worn depending on preferences of child or parent.*

This includes:

- Green sweatshirt or cardigan (available with school logo)
- White polo shirt (available with school logo)
- Grey trousers
- Grey skirt or pinafore dress (knee length)
- Green checked dresses in summer term or warmer weather
- Grey long shorts are permitted in summer term or warmer weather
- Black sensible shoes - not trainers
