<i>The comments that have received have been that some parents did not like the informal style of the first parents evening being an open afternoon. This has previously worked well but your views have been taken into account and this will be changed for next year. <i>In the questionnaire you asked that the responses were based on this academic year due to a new Headteacher. The questionnaire was sent out after 14 school weeks. We would hope that this would be seen as a positive move and that, as seen in this response, your suggestions and concerns we taken into account, acknowledged and responded to. Please also be aware that you can contact the school at any time via email, during school hours by phone and also Mr Armer is on the playground most mornings / afternoons, as are many other members of staff.</i>

<i>Teachers are on the playground each morning before the whistle. You can also contact the school office at any time via email or phone during school hours if you need to contact the class teacher.</i>

<i>The behaviour at Sutton Green is good and is supported by the Good to be Green system. There are occasions where some behaviour has to be addressed but this is a very small percentage. Behaviour is closely monitored by the Senior Leadership Team to ensure that behaviour is, at least, good.</i>			

Staff encourage my child to become mature and independent	96%	1%	3%
The school provides appropriate homework	88%	12%	
<i>Homework was an area that was identified earlier in the year and was a reason for purchasing Sumdog for years 1-6 (each child has an individual login). This online package can be accessed anytime, even if not set as the main homework, for the pupils to work on Maths and English. Reception Homework is updated weekly on the class page. The Senior Leadership will look further into this area.</i>			
My child is not bullied at school	90%	10%	
<i>Bullying can be an overused term which is used when children fall out or don't get along. Bullying is defined as the <u>repetitive, intentional</u> harming of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power. Bullying is, therefore: Deliberately hurtful Repeated, often over a period of time Difficult to defend against At Sutton Green we take bullying very seriously and investigate any allegations.</i>

<i>The School Council will be looking into this area as a whole school, as will the teachers with their classes.</i>



