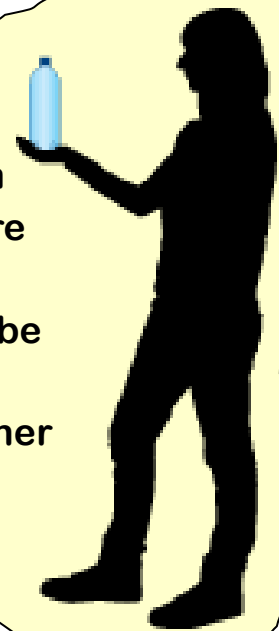

Questionnaire Feedback

As already mentioned, the response to the Parent Questionnaire was so low that it is hard to draw out any trends or issues. From the forms that showed areas of 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree' there were only 2-5 people that had this response so that is about 2% of the school.

However, I would like to comment on some of these areas:

⇒ **Homework:**

- ⇒ The school / PTA have invested in **Sumdog** (Year 1-6) which can be accessed at any time and has a range of enjoyable activities that your child can use. This automatically adjusts the level to suit your child's ability.
- ⇒ Espresso: An online resource that can be accessed at home.
- ⇒ Some year groups will be given homework that is needed to prepare them for standardised testing—Year 1 Phonics test and Year 2 & 6 SATs.
- ⇒ Homework sheets to further develop work being completed in class.

⇒ **Bullying**—If you have a concern about this please see Mrs Payne as we can not deal with anonymous concerns. We have no incidents of bullying (we do have children who fall out). As a school we address the issue in class, in assemblies and also during anti-bullying week.

⇒ **Keeping you informed on how your child is doing.** We have a 'meet the teacher' session (September) in addition to parents evening once a term, (we took on board your feedback about the open evening and so will change this for next year by also having a traditional parents evening) and we also have the end of year reports. Teachers are on the playground each morning and can also be contacted via the school office (phone or email) if you would like a meeting.

⇒ **A range of activities.** We are putting in place plans for more sports clubs for next year but unfortunately the cost from outside providers can be quite high—as seen in the "Mad about Science" Club. Our teachers try their best to provide clubs where they can but please be aware that our teachers work extremely long hours (out of the school day) tirelessly planning, marking and preparing lessons etc. for your children.
