Week Beginning: Monday 23rd March 2020

Good Morning Cherry Class!

Here are your **weekly** learning activities. I will contact you every day to update you on new activities or to remind you of what you could be doing.

Reading	Work through your reading activity booklets – one comprehension per day. Read books on Oxford Reading Buddy and complete quizzes.
Writing	Imagine you are a Viking skald or poet. Create a poem to sing the praises of a friend or family member.
Maths	Create your own shop using items from around your house and work out prices. How much change would you need to give from a £5 or a £10 note? Write and solve your own word problems involving money.
Topic	Look at animals in Viking art (search online for the Urnes or Jellinge styles). Can you design and draw an imaginary beast to make a fantastic pattern?
Optional Challenge	Find out about real treasure (often known as hoards) discovered from the Viking and Anglo-Saxon period. Sutton Hoo and the Staffordshire Hoard are good examples. You might find information on hoards close to your school. However, exact locations are often kept secret Make your own treasure map of the local area. Where would you hide your hoard?

Daily Updates: This section will be added to daily before 9am.

Monday	Write a book review for your favourite book. Would you recommend it to a friend? Impress an adult with your 7 times tables.
Tuesday	Design a Viking weapon. What materials would you need to create it? Could you create a prototype using materials from around your house? Ask an adult to help! Complete a times tables grid.
Wednesday	Research typical Saxon or Viking costume. Imagine that you lived during those times. Are you a farmer, warrior, child or tradesperson? Design and draw your own costume. Read a story to someone in your house (your turn to be the teacher!)
Thursday	Find out about the Futhark alphabet (also known as the runic alphabet), used by the Vikings. Write a short message using the runic characters. Vikings wrote on wood, bone and stone.
Friday	Look at images of Anglo-Saxon coins. Can you design a coin? You could draw a picture or use modelling clay, homemade playdough or other materials to make your coin look like metal – use your imagination! Find a Cosmic Yoga story that you like on YouTube Will your family join in?
