Reading	Work through your reading activity booklets – one comprehension per day. Read books on Oxford Reading Buddy and complete quizzes.
Maths	Complete the daily lessons provided by White Rose for Home Learning. Thank you to Mia V, Daniel, Jasmine, Connor K, Oliver, Darcy and Mia H for sending me emails before the holidays with your brilliant work attached. ☐</p> <p>Today's daily challenge is to research the RNLI and present your findings in an interesting way.</p> <p>You could use a computer/tablet to make a Google slides/PowerPoint presentation, you could write a report, you could design an information leaflet.</p> <p>Who are the RNLI? Who do they help? What sort of equipment do they use? Where would you find them? Why do we need them? How are they funded?</p>
Tuesday	<p>Take a look at this picture: https://www.pobble365.com/on-the-rocks/ Can you write me a story about the ship's crew being rescued? Try to use language that builds tension and suspense. Here are some top tips:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Use short sentences e.g. The captain's heart pounded.- Use ellipsis (...) to create <i>what happens next?</i> moments e.g. He could hear the water rising up...- Use similes and metaphors to describe e.g. The rocks cut like a knife through the ship. <p>Make sure that your story has a happy ending! Use your learning from yesterday to help to plan the rescue of the ship's crew.</p>
Wednesday	<p>Build a lifeboat! Today I would like you to design a lifeboat, carefully thinking about the materials you would need and what you need to have onboard. Perhaps you could build a prototype out of recyclable materials and test it in the sink, bath or a paddling pool. Thursday	<p>Watch the story of Grace Darling: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Yv3eS40j0N0 Create a comic book strip to retell the key parts of Grace Darling's heroic rescue of the sailors.</p>
Friday	<p>Research how to stay safe at the beach. Find out how lifeguards and the RNLI show visitors how safe the water is, and what rules people should follow when at the beach. Think about flags, suncream, inflatables and swimming.</p> <p>Create a poster to show the most important rules, make sure it is bright and eye-catching, as well as informative.</p>
