Reading	Work through your reading activity booklets – one comprehension per day. Read books on Oxford Reading Buddy and complete quizzes.
Maths	Complete the daily lessons provided by White Rose for Home Learning. Make sure that you complete the lessons in order, so you don't miss out any important skills needed for the next lesson. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-4/ I have also set a special SumDog challenge, which is open for 2 weeks. It is all about Fractions, Decimals and Percentages.
Topic	Our new topic is... People who help us. This week we are going to learn about the Emergency Services. Read through the emergency situations, then the prepare and response cards. Can you think of another emergency? How would you prepare and respond? Create your own cards.
Writing	Visit https://www.pobble365.com/the-tsunami and look at the photo. Use the story starter to write a story about the emergency. Try to use some fronted adverbials to set the scene. Look at the fronted adverbial sheet for some inspiration.
Optional Challenge	How prepared are you for an emergency? Do you know your address and phone numbers? Try to learn this important information.

Monday	<p>White Rose daily Maths lesson – see link above.</p> <p>Sentence challenge! A complex sentence must contain a subordinate clause. This is a clause that doesn't make sense on its own. E.g. Although the man had miraculously managed to prevent the waves from crashing down onto the people, they were still extremely frightened!</p> <p>Write a complex sentence of your own and underline your subordinate clause. If you find this tricky, practice saying your sentences before you write them.</p> <p>Try starting your sentence with: As While When If Even though</p>
Tuesday	<p>White Rose daily Maths lesson – see link above.</p> <p>Sick sentences! These sentences are 'sick' and need help to get better. Can you help? Try to improve the vocabulary as well as the punctuation.</p> <p>the waves fought against the man. he stood still. he waved his staff. the waves went back. the people in the cars were scared. the tsunami was high up. the people could see sharks in the water.</p>
Wednesday	<p>White Rose daily Maths lesson – see link above.</p> <p>Find out about paramedics. Who are they? What do they do? What uniform do they wear? How do they travel?</p> <p>Create me an information poster – you can use ICT or do it by hand.</p>
Thursday	<p>White Rose daily Maths lesson – see link above.</p> <p>Design a brand new uniform and ambulance for a paramedic to use. Draw labelled diagrams of them. Try to make it as detailed as possible to show off your home learning.</p>
Friday	<p>White Rose daily Maths lesson – see link above.</p> <p>St John Ambulance is a voluntary organisation that provides first aid in the community and at public events, like a school fair.
