Our classroom doors are open from 8.40am to start the day at 8.50am. The school day ends at 3.15. You drop off and collect your children from the external classroom doors. We will have notice boards out on the first day so you can see where to go.

What can I do as a parent to help prepare my child for their first day?

- Walk/cycle to the school gates so that the children are familiar with the journey. They could try on their new uniform and start by getting into a routine of waking up at the right time in the morning and getting ready for the day.
- Have regular chats about starting school - make it sound like the exciting adventure that it is! There are some great 'Starting School' stories that you could share too.
- Practise tasks such as going to the toilet and washing their hands independently, putting on their coat, undoing zips and buttons, using cutlery, opening & closing a lunch box.





General Information

Infant children are entitled to a **FREE** healthy snack in the morning and a **FREE** school lunch. More details to follow.

If your child brings a packed lunch it should be clearly labelled with a name on the box and bottle. No nut products please.

Coats and wellingtons needed as we spend a lot of time outdoors.



Uniform

A range of uniform may be worn depending on preferences of child or parent.

This includes:

- Green sweatshirt or cardigan (available with school logo)
- White polo shirt (available with school logo)
- Grey trousers
- Grey skirt or pinafore dress (knee length)
- Green checked dresses in summer term or warmer weather
- Grey long shorts are permitted in summer term or warmer weather
- Black sensible shoes - not trainers
